

INTRODUCING THE WORKSHOP

Ask students to look closely at the photograph. Have students describe what the girls in the photograph are doing. Read aloud the caption and have students connect to their prior knowledge about video games they have played or seen. Have groups briefly describe anything that might be considered violent in video games they know about.



Video games are a popular form of entertainment and are enjoyed by millions of people all around the world. There are, however, those who feel that some video games contain too much violence and other objectionable content so should be restricted or banned. They worry about how the games may impact those who play them.
